

Track Photography Rules and Guidelines

PETALUMA SPEEDWAY TRACK PHOTOGRAPHY RULES AND GUIDELINES

Petaluma Speedway welcomes you and hopes that your efforts produce some great photos for you, however in order to assure safety and a smooth running show, the following rules and guidelines have been put into place.

1. All track photographers will check in at the pit gate. Any visiting track photographer must present and leave with the pit gate a business card indicating their business as a photographer. Also, visiting track photographers must show credentials from a previous motorsports event and obtain clearance from the speedway.
2. All photographers are required to wear at any time they are in the pits, infield, or any other area with the exception of the grandstands a safety vest colored either safety orange, yellow, or safety green. This is to ensure visibility as to the photographer's location to drivers, safety crews, and officials.
3. Photographers may only photograph from track corners, infield, or backstretch crow's nest with permission from an official. Crossing of the track is performed from the pit gate on the back stretch and must be cleared by an official when cars are active. At no time are you to be on the track side of the gate when the track is green.
4. When in the infield, all photographers will stay INSIDE of the large tires around the area between the infield and the racing surface. You may not enter the racing surface unless cleared by an official at all times.
5. No alcohol or illicit drug consumption prior to or during the night will be permitted. You may however purchase alcohol after the race event.
6. If you enter the grandstands area without a track official escort, you will not be permitted to return to the pits or infield.
7. If you are found in violation of any of these guidelines, any outlined in the All-Pro General Rules, or at the discretion of the Chief Stewart, you will be asked to leave the premises and may face temporary or permanent suspension.
